GCSE Results 2022





- Our average Attainment 8 grade was 5.16
- 77.6% students achieved Grade 4 and above in English & Mathematics
- 62.7% students achieved Grade 5 and above in English & Mathematics
- 82% students entered for the English Baccalaureate achieved this at Grade 4+, 55% at Grade 5+
- Students at UWS made significantly more progress than others nationally in: Biology, DT, Geography, Mathematics, RE and Combined Science
- 21% BTEC grades were at Distinction (Enterprise: 44% L2D+, 100% L2P+)
- NCFE Interactive Media: 29% L2D+, 94% L2P+

This year's results are superb and are testament to the outstanding resilience of our students, given the challenges they have faced.

They have sustained the outstanding progress made by students at UWS in 2019 (and subsequently in the school-assessed grades of the following two years).

We are delighted that as a result of this success, all of our students have been able to move onto their destination of choice.

21% all grades awarded were at Grade 7 or higher, with 20 Grade 9s. Importantly, 77% students gained at least 5 standard passes (Grade 4 or higher) including English and Mathematics, with 63% achieving at least 5 strong passes at 5+ (again including English and Mathematics).

On average, a UWS student will achieve well over half a grade higher than their targets across a range of subjects; a just reward for all of their hard work over the five years.

Each graph shows subject's headline figures against this years national average figure.










