1 School Uniform

The following uniform must be worn by Students in school, and clearly marked with the student's name:

- *School sweatshirt in bottle green;
- *For Y11 students only – School sweatshirt in black;
- *Official school white polo shirt;
- Black tailored trousers (no stripes or embroidery);
- Black skirt (no stripes or embroidery) which must be worn with heavy denier, non-patterned black tights;
- Grey or black socks or heavy denier, non-patterned black tights;
- Plain black shoes (not boots, trainers, sports shoes or pumps);
- Student Lanyard and ID card – this must be worn at all time during the school day.

Please note:

- Shorts leggings and denim are not permitted;
- For religious reasons, some students may wish to wear a headscarf or Salwar kameez - which must be plain black.

2 PE Kit

- *Official school green and navy polo shirt;
- *Navy and green shorts;
- Green football socks;
- White sports socks;
- Swimming kit (not beachwear);
- Swimming goggles;
- Trainers;
- Football boots;
- Gum shield;
- Shin pads;
- *Navy and green Rugby shirt.

The following items are optional:

- Plain navy tracksuit bottoms - no stripes (*boys and girls*)
- *Navy and green training top (*girls*)
- *Navy Netball skort (*girls*)

3 Jewellery, Make Up & Hair Colour

- Jewellery is limited to ear studs. For health and safety reasons necklaces should not be visible.
- No jewellery at all may be worn in any PE or games lesson.
- Make-up, including nails, should be discreet.

- Hair must be a natural colour.

4 Equipment

- Equipment includes pens, pencils, ruler, rubber, calculator, pencil sharpener, pencil crayons or felt tip pens.
- Students should come to school every day with the equipment, books and folders they require for the day.
- Replacement stationery can be purchased from the AV Room.
- Students must always have their student planner and reading book.
- Students must bring their PE Kit into school on the days they need it.

5 Additional Information

- Coats, scarves and hats must not be worn inside classrooms.
- You must not bring any dangerous or illegal items to school, including anything that could be perceived as such. The school has the right to confiscate any dangerous or illegal items for their protection and for the protection of others. Teachers will also confiscate any articles that are used inappropriately in school.
- If there are any doubts about particular items of uniforms, please contact the school before purchasing.
- The Executive Headteacher and Head of School reserve the right to insist on our uniform policy and make any final decisions regarding specific items or breaches of the policy.
