1 School Uniform

The following uniform must be worn by students in school, and must clearly marked with the **student's name**:

3 Jewellery, Make Up & Hair Colour

- The only earrings permitted are plain, simple style ear studs

- Students may wear a wristwatch
- Rings, bracelets and anklets are not permitted at any time
- Nose studs and non-ear visible piercings are not permitted
- For health and safety reasons necklaces should not be visible
- No jewellery at all may be worn in any PE or games lesson/activity
- Any make-up worn must not be visible
- Overtly visible false eyelashes and heavily coloured eyebrows are not permitted for school
- For health and safety reasons no false nails are permitted and all nails should be short and be of a natural colour
- Hair must be a single, natural colour

4 Equipment

- Equipment includes pens, pencils, ruler, rubber, calculator, pencil sharpener, pencil crayons or felt tip pens.
- Students should come to school every day with the stationery equipment, books and folders they require for the day.
- Replacement stationery can be purchased from the AV Room.
- Students must **always** have their reading book.
- Students must bring their **PE Kit** into school on the days they need it.

5 Additional Information

- Coats, scarves and hats must not be worn inside classrooms or in the Hall
- Lanyards must be worn and be visible at all times when on the school site
- You must not bring any dangerous or illegal items to school, including anything which could be perceived as such. The school has the right to confiscate any dangerous or illegal items for their protection and for the protection of others. Teachers will also confiscate any articles that are used inappropriately or are not permitted in school.
- If there are any doubts about particular items of uniform, please contact the school before purchasing.
